Description	The Forum is an intense one-and-a-half day of meetings. We've built in plenty of time for informal interactions and relationship building during the breaks, reception and meals. Although this is not a "holiday" type of program, there are comfortable facilities in this waterfront setting should a participant wish to arrive early or stay on afterwards. In keeping with the above, this is an in-person event. There will be no virtual option.
Program Notes	The program is being developed by a volunteer Steering Committee of your peers and it forms the basis of the discussions. To ensure an open and candid exchange of ideas, participants agree that all discussions will be under the Chatham House Rule. Participants are free to use the information discussed, but not to attribute specific comments to individuals or their organizations. ACEC-Canada is a member of Transparency International Canada and will ensure that the subject matter discussed is appropriate and that the integrity of the Forum and its participants are protected.
All Inclusive Fee	The <i>all-inclusive fee</i> covers two nights accommodation at Château-Vaudreuil, all meals and refreshments, and meeting sessions and materials. The Forum is \$2,400.00 (+HST) payable by credit card. *Please note that the Forum is limited to 35 participants; and places are reserved on a first come, first served basis. Your place can only be confirmed upon receipt of payment.
